ISTANBUL PHARMACY FROM 1919 UNTIL 2009

The members of the congress, ministers and the national leader Ataturk -who became the founder of the Turkish Republic after the War of Independence- had great efforts encouraging Pharmacist Hüseyin Hüsnü Sarıbey to open the second pharmacy in Ankara. Pharm. H. Hüsnü Sarıbey came to the city and opened up his pharmacy under the title of Istanbul Pharmacy. This historical pharmacy was established in the period of "War of Independence". Before this, Pharm. Hüseyin Hüsnü Sarıbey was a hospital pharmacist serving for the government. İstanbul Pharmacy was managed by Pharm. H. Hüsnü Sarıbey from 1919 till 1960. When he died, the pharmacy was operated by his son Adil Sarıbey with a licensed pharmacist for some time. Adil Sarıbey turned his father's pharmacy over Pharmacist Omer Faruk Erdem in 1979 with all it's belongings. This historcal pharmacy has a significant place as it has provided Ataturk's all the medicines till 17th October 1938. And another hallmark is the owner of the pharmacy in nowadays. Pharm. Omer Faruk Erdem still preserves the documents left by Pharm. Hüseyin Hüsnü Sarıbey and prepares magistral prescriptions to his patients. He mainly produces remedies for diaper rash, hemorrhoid, gastritis, corne. The aim of this research is to reveal the documents and the magistral prescriptions peculiar to Istanbul Pharmacy.
