- April 12, 1961, First man in space: Juri Alexejewitsch Gagarin (1934-1968)
- June 16, 1963, First woman in space: Valentina Vladimirovna Tereshkova (*1937)
- August 6, 1961, First man to fly longer than 24 hours: Gherman Stepanovich Titov (1935-2000)
- March 18, 1965, First spacewalk: Alexei Arkhipovich Leonov (*1934)
- October 13, 1964, First 3-mencrew


USA caught up




